Frisian is a compulsory subject for primary schools in the province of Friesland. Schools may apply to the provincial executive for exemption if less than 5% of pupils at the school have a Frisian background. Extra subjects. Schools may choose to teach extra subjects in addition to the compulsory core curriculum, such as religious education, French or German. Parents can give their opinion on extra subjects through the school's participation council.
