In Nederland ben je vrij om niet-godsdienstig te zijn, maar in de praktijk is die vrijheid niet voor iedereen vanzelfsprekend. In Nieuwe vrijdenkers komen twaalf Nederlandse voormalige moslims aan het woord die zich hebben losgemaakt van de religie van hun ouders. Bij sommigen ging dat gemakkelijk, maar anderen kregen te maken met zeer heftige reacties van hun familie, waarbij enkelen zelfs werden verstoten. Een aantal van de geïnterviewden is nu openlijk atheïst, agnost, humanist of vrijdenker, maar velen van hen leiden een dubbelleven omdat de buitenwereld niets weet van hun afvalligheid. De nieuwe vrijdenkers vertellen openhartig over hun soms verscheurende dilemma's, maar ook over waar ze zich tegenwoordig door laten inspireren. Het zijn stuk voor stuk verhalen over het Nederland van nu. Boris van der Ham (Amsterdam, 1973) groeide op in Nieuwkoop. Hij is onder andere voorzitter van het Humanistisch Verbond en werkte mee aan twee documentaires over afvalligheid in de islam. Rachid Benhammo (Beni Bouyahie, Marokko, 1973) groeide op in Rotterdam. Hij is cultureel ondernemer en freelancejournalist.

Gnostic writings offer striking perspectives on both early Christian and non-Christian thought. For example, some gnostic texts suggest that god should be celebrated as both mother and father, and that self-knowledge is the supreme path to the divine. Only in the past fifty years has it become clear how far the gnostic influence spread in ancient and medieval religions—and what a marvelous body of scriptures it produced. The selections gathered here, in poetic, readable translation, represent Jewish, Christian, Hermetic, Mandaean, Manichaeism, Islamic, and Cathar expressions of gnostic spirituality. Their regions of origin include Egypt, the Greco-Roman world, the Middle East, Syria, Iraq, China, and France. Tras la muerte de su padre, comenzó una búsqueda de la verdad a través de la ciencia, la filosofía y la historia, eventualmente encontró respuestas en el cristianismo. En una manera simpática y persuasiva, este libro responde a las diez preguntas acerca de Dios en la época actual, incluyendo: • ¿Existe Dios? • ¿Qué hacemos con la historia violenta del cristianismo? • ¿Es Jesús otro mito? • ¿Podemos confiar en la Biblia? • ¿Por qué todavía debemos creer en el infierno? El libro concluye con la aseveración más audaz del cristianismo: ¿cómo debemos responder a la afirmación de que Jesús es Dios y el único camino de salvación?

The first student text and teacher resource in the series is God's Word Revealed in Sacred Scripture, which has been found to be in conformity with the USCCB Protocols for Assessing the Conformity of Catechetical Materials with the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The Credo series takes as its starting point the lived experience of the students and challenges them to make their lives a lived response to the teachings of the Catholic Church. The person and message of Jesus Christ is central to the Credo series. The students will be helped to come to know Jesus Christ more deeply and to understand his teachings more fully. The Credo series also focuses on the formation of the students as people of faith. Each chapter facilitates their reflection on the meaning of what they are learning for their lives. Through prayer and meditative exercises they are helped to experience the presence of God in their lives. The Credo series has a strong social justice theme running throughout. The text moves 'from life to faith to life' in a repeated pattern or spiral, leading the students to 'know, to love, to serve', moving from information to formation to transformation. The Credo series uses the Shared Christian Praxis pedagogy which was developed by Tom Groome, and in the Credo series it is adapted for the first time for High School Catechesis. The Credo series speaks to the multicultural nature of the US High School population.

Gregorian chant, or less commonly known as Carolingian chant is the central tradition of Western plainchant, a form of monophonic liturgical music within Western Orthodoxy that accompanied the celebration of Divine Liturgy and other ritual services. It is named after Pope Gregory I, Bishop of Rome from 590 to 604, who is traditionally credited for having ordered the simplification and cataloging of music assigned to specific celebrations in the church calendar.
