One day, Dolmetsch's son Carl, who was carrying one of the historic recorders that belonged to the family, left the instrument on the platform at a railway station when boarding a train. Although Arnold searched relentlessly for the instrument, it could not be found. However, fortunately, he was able to create detailed schematics based on the documentation for the old recorder.Â However, as it was completely forgotten by people for a period of time, its restoration from the 20th century onwards has preserved its historic shape.
