Science fiction fandom started through the letter column of Hugo Gernsback's fiction magazines. Not only did fans write comments about the stories—they sent their addresses, and Gernsback published them. Soon, fans were writing letters directly to each other, and meeting in person when they lived close together, or when one of them could manage a trip. A widely regarded (though by no means error-free) history of fandom in the 1930s can be found in Sam Moskowitz's *The Immortal Storm: A History of Science Fiction Fandom* Hyperion Press 1988.
